## To Do List

- -Write to-dos in the correct sections.

- -If you hit your stride, Try to Get Ahead

- -Move all your unfinished tasks to the new list.
- -Don't keep old lists!
- -I've included small cut-able task sheets too!

## Household Shopping List

- -Put the template in a central location (like the fridge).
- -Add items to sections.
- -As soon as you run out of an item at home, write it on the list.
- -Take the list with you to the store (duhzies).
- -Fold the list like an accordion, trust me.
- -Shop according to section/department.
- -Fold the accordion list like a book as you go. You see less, so less to forget!!!
